Simplifying Prep Instructions for Patients

One of the things that detain people from getting their screening colonoscopies is the prep. Many have faced bad experiences with the mixture they had to drink; others have heard bad experiences from family or friends. We want to make patients see the improvements in the prep process and that it is not as daunting as it may seem.

Our first step in helping patients was a video that details the prep process step-by-step, from start to finish. We send the link to these videos to patients a few days before their procedure; we want them to understand what they need to do, get everything they need, and be ready when the time comes to start the prep. The videos are

Our second step was creating a handout for patients that helps them fully understand what to expect when they come to our office for their procedure. It is given to patients when they schedule their exam and explains what happens at:
